9:15am–10:15am	Overnight Accommodations Student Check-In/ Drop-Off Osceola Hall or Volusia Hall	For students staying overnight, check-in with our Apollo Housing Team and move into your residence hall room for the night (either in Osceola Hall or Volusia Hall). We'll make sure following move-in that you are directed to where to park for Orientation and then to our official Orientation Check-In location.
